APPLICATION PROCESS AND GUIDELINES FOR OBTAINING CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY IN KOGI STATE

Under the Governor of Kogi State Executive Order Number 03 of 2022, Establishing Kogi State Geographic Information System Agency available online at KOGIS-AGENCY.pdf (kogistate.gov.ng) individuals and companies can apply and obtain a CofO from the Kogi State Geographic Information System Agency by following the guidelines below:
